


3.0 DESCRIPTION:

THE MODEL ND-15 IS A DUAL RANGE PERSONAL RADIATION ALARM WHICH PROVIDES AN IMMEDIATE AUDIBLE INDICATION OF CHANGING RADIATION LEVELS.

THE SIGNALS ARE HIGH PITCHED "CHIRPS" WHICH INCREASE IN FREQUENCY TO THE PROPORTION OF THE GAMMA OR X-RAY PRESENT. THE DUAL RANGE ALARM FEATURE PROVIDES A HIGH RANGE FOR NORMAL MONITORING PURPOSES, SUCH AS DURING RADIOGRAPHY (NOT ANNOYING TO THE USER) AND A LOW RANGE THAT IS ESPECIALLY USEFUL IN CHECKING FOR LEAKAGE FROM X-RAY OR RADIOACTIVE SOURCES AND FOR DETERMINING IF EXCESSIVE STRAY RADIATION EXISTS.

THE CONSTRUCTION OF THE UNIT IS DESIGNED FOR LONG, DEPENDABLE SERVICE UNDER EXTREME CONDITIONS. THE MODEL ND-15 IS HOUSED IN A DIE-CAST ALUMINUM CASE WITH .09 INCH MATERIAL THICKNESS FOR ADDED DURABILITY.

4.0 SPECIFICATIONS:

- 4.1 DETECTOR: HALOGEN QUENCHED, ENERGY COMPENSATED GEIGER MUELLER TUBE. EFFECTIVE LENGTH AND DIAMETER: 0.625 INCH x 0.194 INCH. WALL THICKNESS IS 90mg/cm SQUARED.
- 4.2 ALARM: SOLID STATE, AUDIO-TONE TRANSDUCER WHICH EMITS 100 dBs AT 6 INCHES.
- 4.3 CONTROLS: SWITCH SELECTED
 - LOW RANGE: 60 CHIRPS/MIN IN A 1 mR/hr FIELD.
 - HIGH RANGE: 60 CHIRPS/MIN IN A 30 mR/hr FIELD.
- 4.4 POWER: ON/OFF SWITCH.
- 4.5 BATTERY: 9 VOLT TRANSISTOR, ALKALINE FOR LONGER LIFE
- 4.6 BATTERY LIFE: APPROXIMATELY 6 MONTHS IN NORMAL USE, 8 HOURS/DAY, 5 DAYS/WEEK AT LOW RADIATION LEVELS.
- 4.7 SIZE: 4.375 INCHES HIGH x 2.375 INCHES WIDE x 1.25 INCHES DEEP (NOT INCLUDING BELT LOOP).
- 4.8 WEIGHT: 8 OUNCES APPROX. INCLUDES BATTERY.
- 4.9 CALIBRATION CONTROLS: NONE, FACTORY SET/ADJUSTABLE.

5.0 LIMITATION (SATURATION) * CAUTION *

IT IS A WELL KNOWN PHENOMENON THAT ALL GEIGER-MUELLER SURVEY METERS SATURATE OR OVERLOAD AT SOME POINT (THIS MAY BE CALLED FLOODING OR JAMMING). THIS PARTICULAR MODEL WILL SATURATE WHEN IN A RADIATION FIELD IN EXCESS OF 1000 R/hr WHEN IT HAS BEEN PROPERLY MAINTAINED. IF THE RADIATION FIELD IS IN EXCESS OF 1000 R/hr, ONE OF TWO EVENTS WILL OCCUR: 1) THE INSTRUMENT WILL EMIT A CONTINUOUS "CHIRP" AND ONCE IT REACHES SATURATION, IT WILL STOP, OR 2) IF THE INSTRUMENT IS TURNED ON IN A FIELD IN EXCESS OF 1000 R/hr. THE INSTRUMENT WILL NOT REACT.

ALTHOUGH A 1000 R/hr FIELD IS EXTREMELY HIGH AND MAY NEVER BE ENCOUNTERED, PROPER RADIATION SAFETY PROCEDURES AND REGULATIONS SHOULD BE OBSERVED WHEN MAKING ANY TYPE OF RADIATION SURVEY.

6.0 INSTRUMENT OPERATION:

THE ND-15 COMES WITH AN INSTALLED 9 VOLT BATTERY. WHEN THE POWER SWITCH IS FIRST TURNED ON, A SINGLE CHIRP SHOULD BE HEARD. IF THE UNIT IS OPERATING PROPERLY, A LOW FREQUENCY (ABOUT 400/SEC) "MOTOTBOATING" SOUND WILL BE HEARD WHEN THE UNIT IS HELD CLOSE TO THE EAR IN A QUIET LOCATION.


THE INSTRUMENT SHOULD BE CHECKED PERIODICALLY BY MOVING THE UNIT TOWARD OR AWAY FROM A RADIATION SOURCE. WHILE DOING THIS, OBSERVE THE RATE CHANGE OF CHIRPS.

NOTE: DO NOT USE WHEN THE TEMPERATURE IS ABOVE 55 DEGREES CENTIGRADE.

7.0 MAINTENANCE:

- 7.1 WHEN THE INSTRUMENT IS ON, YOU WILL HEAR A CONTINUOUS, LOW FREQUENCY "MOTOR-BOATING" SOUND WHEN HELD NEAR THE EAR. IF THERE IS NO SOUND, CHANGE THE BATTERY BY UNSCREWING THE BACKPLATE AND INSTALLING NEW 9V BATTERY.
- 7.2 KEEP INSTRUMENT FREE OF DIRT AND DUST.
- 7.3 KEEP INSTRUMENT DRY. IF IT SHOULD GET WET DO NOT USE UNTIL COMPLETELY DRY.
- 7.4 THE INSTRUMENT IS DESIGNED TO BE WORN ON THE BELT. THIS WILL REDUCE UNNECESSARY VIBRATIONS AND SHOCK THAT MAY CAUSE DAMAGE (SUCH AS KNOCKING UNIT OFF TABLES, LEDGES, ETC.). IF DROPPED, CHECK FUNCTIONALITY BEFORE REUSING.
- 7.5 REMEMBER: THE ND-15 IS A SAFETY DEVICE DESIGNED TO REDUCE YOUR OVEREXPOSURES. WITH PROPER CARE IT WILL GIVE YOU LONG AND DEPENDABLE SERVICE.
- 7.6 WARNING: THIS INSTRUMENT CONTAINS CMOS DEVICES. NO SERVICE SHOULD EVER BE ATTEMPTED BY OTHER THAN A COMPETENT TECHNICIAN THOROUGHLY FAMILIAR WITH THESE COMPONENTS. CURRENT LEAKAGE IN SOLDERING IRONS OR OTHER NON-GROUNDED TOOLS ALONG WITH STATIC ELECTRICITY CAN INSTANTLY DESTROY CMOS ICS. SINCE THIS UNIT HAS IC SOCKETS DO NOT ATTEMPT TO REMOVE OR REPLACE THE ICS WITHOUT OBSERVING ESD PRECAUTIONS.
